

Multiply Maine Missions Information- Summer 2020

Dates: Monday, 7pm through Saturday, 9am

Cost: \$289 per person per week (5 nights). This includes lodging, ministry supplies, nightly worship, ministry and most recreational activities and most meals. Does not include lunches, travel meals, or Friday night dinner. (Those meals are the responsibility of each person- about \$75) Please note: the fee applies to all group participants regardless of age.

Transportation: Getting to and around Maine is the responsibility of each group. Multiply Maine may be able to provide transportation for an additional fee. Please check with our office as we can give advice on ways to do this economically and efficiently.

Registration: Please pre-register your group ASAP to reserve your week by returning the group registration form. A non-refundable deposit of \$100 per person should be sent to our office. All deposit money will be applied to the final balance owed. The remaining balance is due in our office by May 15, 2020. Registrations are not complete and final until all individual forms and full payment is received in our office. Each individual must read the information sheet before registering, and ALL individual registration/waiver forms must be in our office BEFORE arrival.

Schedule: Our week will officially begin after dinner on Monday night at 7pm. The week will end with breakfast on Saturday morning. Adhering to this schedule is very important for the continuity of the week, and everyone is asked to be present *from Monday 7pm until Saturday 9am.*

Lodging: Lodging will be provided at the home of Roger and Caroline Ferrell, who use their 1824 farmhouse as a mission sending and serving center or at one of our missions houses in the area. Beds, pillows, sheets, blankets, and towels will all be provided. PLEASE NOTE- smoking is not permitted at our lodging facility or any ministry site. Also, Lewis the cat, our mission center mascot, is in residence and looks forward to meeting you.

Food: Breakfast and dinner will be provided each day beginning Tuesday morning except for Friday night when your group can eat on your own (this is when most groups get their lobster, if they want it, and we are glad to make recommendations.) We work you hard while you are here, so we feed you very well, with plenty of food! Lunches will be eaten in inexpensive, casual-service restaurants in the communities where we will be working, and will be the responsibility of each person.
